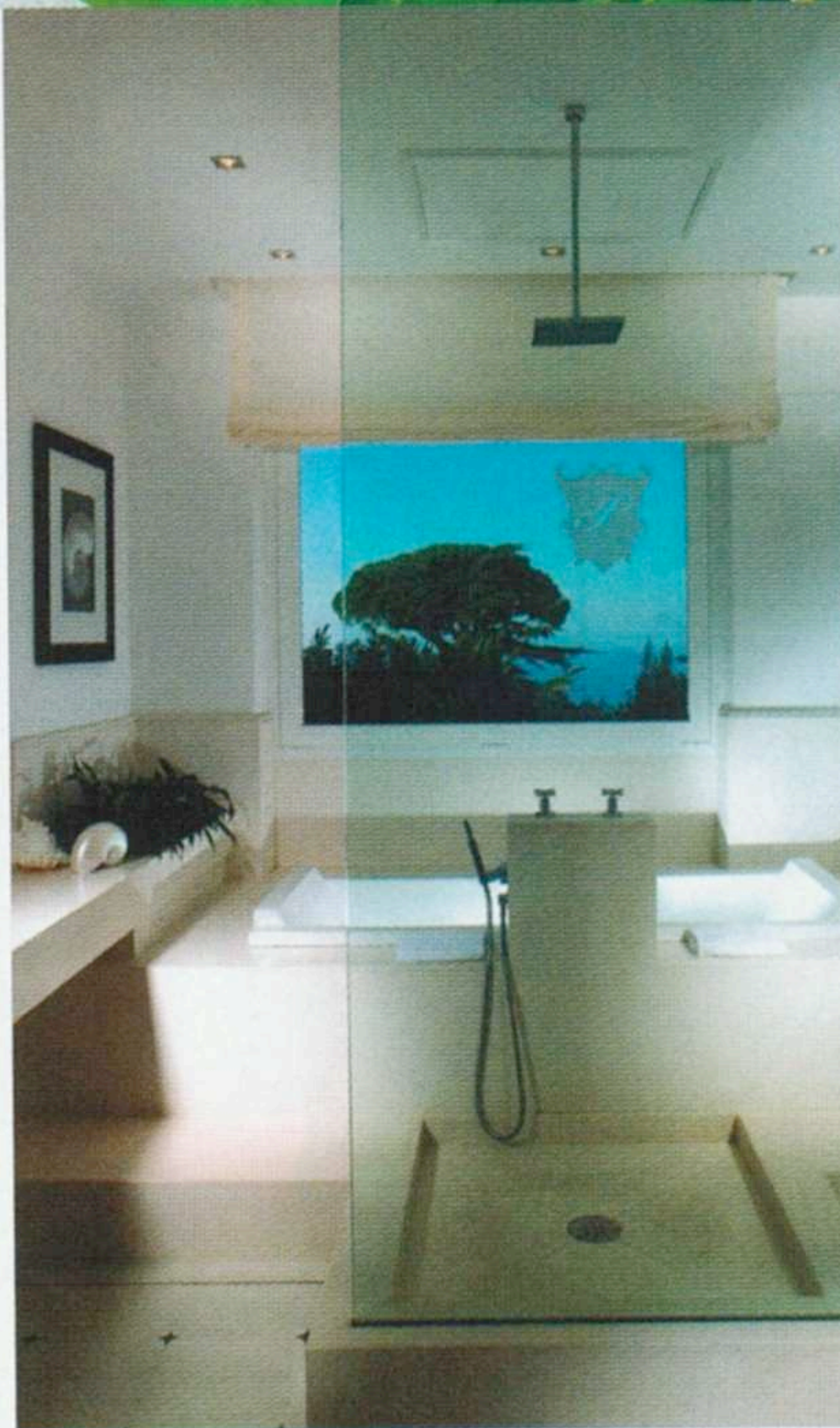




Isarabanjina, Madagascar

This tiny island shot to fame when a stranded Joanna Lumley turned her bras into shoes there in the 1994 documentary *Girl Friday*. Luckily, you won't have to do the same with your honeymoon undies, but the raw beauty seen onscreen – pristine shores, glittering coral and blossoming foliage – remains to give a real Robinson Crusoe-style adventure. Constance Lodge is the only accommodation, and its 21 bungalows shun mod cons such as television and telephones in favour of simple verandas and hammocks. The area is a watersports wonderland, food is straight-from-the-sea fresh and the bar, with a floor covered in silky sand, serves rum cocktails until the last man is no longer standing.

Virgin Holidays (virginholidays.co.uk) offers seven nights, full board, from £1539pp, including flights.



Capri, Italy

Picked by decades of sun-worshipping glamourpusses, glitzy Capri calls for oversized shades, a Posh pout and a scene-stealing bikini. And the Capri Palace Hotel & Spa is the place to flaunt them. Decorated with images of 1950s movie icons and lavish antiques, it has the island's only Michelin-starred restaurant, a vast wine cellar and spectacular views of the Gulf of Naples. Don't tell him, but it's also next door to Capri's main department store Mariorita, where all hotel guests get 10% off chic designers such as Missoni, Valentino and Escada.

Carrier (carrier.co.uk) offers seven nights from £1355pp, including flights and breakfast.



St Lucia, West Indies

Among the banana plantations, rainforests and golden coves lies St Lucia's most famous landmark: the twin Piton mountains, which rise majestically from the emerald sea. Don't remember this astounding view by buying a postcard; make it the scene you wake up to every morning. The beds, living areas and infinity pools at Jade Mountain's rooms all face this mesmerising sight – so you're guaranteed amazing holiday snaps and you won't be spotted by a tour bus if you skinny-dip. Another great vista of the Caribbean comes from the clifftop restaurant at St Lucia's newest boutique hotel, Cap Maison (left). Pick your wine from the walk-in cellar, then toast your future as you gaze out at heaven.

Kuoni World Class (kuoniworldclass.co.uk) offers seven nights at Jade Mountain from £2547pp or at Cap Maison from £1563pp, both including flights.
