A BEACH IN ST BARTS

One of the smallest of the islands that make up the French West Indies, this powdery stretch on the north of the island has lush, green, rocky hills either side that frame sweeping views of the turquoise sea, making an envy-inducing backdrop to all of your wedding

photos. Event planning is made even easier if you stay at Hôtel Saint-Barth Isle de France, a chic low-rise hotel whose airy suites are perched on the sand. The reason?
